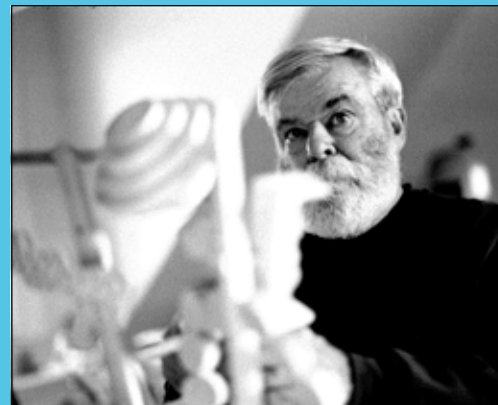


The Lucy Scholten Endowment Fund

"I witnessed Stuart's work not only changing materially but also in the collecting and building of his vocabulary of forms, shapes and images through constant observations of what was taking place around him. There are references to figures and their interactions, references to shapes derived from architecture, landscape and abstract shapes that seemed distilled from all of it. His figurative paintings would often be composed of slightly disjointed shapes. The figure could be alone with its thoughts or a couple in conversation with glyphs emanating from them. The Glyphs have images rather than text and sometimes the glyphs had glyphs that were filled with images."
