### LOT #1 Annie Titchener + Amy Hamlin

Opening Bid: \$100

Annie's intensely layered line work lays the groundwork for Amy's textured overlay.



### LOT #2 Dale Jackson + Bill Ross

Opening Bid: \$100

Bill, a V+V co-founder, provided the backdrop to Dale's unique recitation of the classic rock lyrics "Double Vision."

Opening Bid: \$85

For these "Jugheads", Christine provided the vessel forms adorned by V+V artists David Shelton, Kevin White, Ashley Mays, Brian Dooley, Jackie Covert complete with customized lids.



### LOT #4 Emily Funk + Jolie Harris

Opening Bid: \$200

Jolie and Emily blend their geometric and organic styles to a lush and evocative effect. *(Detail shown).*

### LOT #5 David Callahan + Ryan Mulligan

Opening Bid: \$100

Ryan and David give us two interpretations of a desert landscape presented in the same panel.



### LOT #6 Rosalind Bush + Karen Boyhen

Opening Bid: \$85

Cleverly using found objects and collage techniques, Karen and Rosalind create portraits of four V+V artists at work and play.



### LOT #7 Lamar Madison + Niel Hartman

Opening Bid: \$150

Lamar's explosion of old school boom boxes provides the texture and context for Niel's figures.



### LOT #8 Ruth Burton + Kurt Mayhew

Opening Bid: \$100

In a perfect blend of the artists' individual imagery, Kirk's hand serves as an ideal resting spot for Ruth's birds.

### LOT #9 Daniel Westcott + Ali Calis + Ryan Little

Opening Bid: \$150

Taking cues from Daniel's silhouetted character studies, Able Projects' Ryan and Ali help transform them into large-scale objects.



### LOT #10 Marci Rosen + Jessie Boone

Opening Bid: \$85

Jessie gives Marci's elaborate characters an illustrational overlay. The layering effect adds to the narrative content of the collaboration.



### LOT #11 Brianne Crable + Suzanne Lambert

Opening Bid: \$150

Suzanne and Brianne return to DV3 with another strong collaboration playing off of Suzanne's expressive abstraction and Brianne's bold images. *(Detail shown).*

### LOT #12 Rob Bolubasz + Jan Hermans

Opening Bid: \$100

Jan transferred Rob's intense text- and line-based drawings onto fabric to create this tapestry/wall hanging.



### LOT #13 Rob Macke + Jules Itzkoff/ Higher Level Art

Opening Bid: \$150

Rob's fantastic imagery is an ideal counterpoint to Jules' bold graphic explorations, using vintage book design as a jumping off point. *(Detail shown).*



### LOT #14 Manny Love + Terrence Hammons

Opening Bid: \$85

Terrence's recognizable print pattern is the setting for Manny's bold portraiture and social commentary.



### LOT #15 Leah Davis + Robyn Winkler

Opening Bid: \$200

Using bold colors, Leah and Robyn's whimsical piece delicately (and literally) places birds on a wire.



## Featured Items

The following featured items are non-collaborative pieces by artists outside of the V+V studios.



### LOT #16 Charley Harper

Opening Bid: \$200

The estate of one of Cincinnati's most beloved artists has donated this vintage Charley Harper print, first published in a 1960 Ford Times magazine.



### LOT #17 Kevin T. Kelly

Opening Bid: \$300

One of Cincinnati's most active and visible artists, Kevin T. Kelly makes work that speaks to Pop traditions with bold, graphic lines and colors. This still-life image of flowers receives the artist's treatment and is transformed into a vibrant work of art.



### LOT #18 AVS

Opening Bid: \$300

Cincinnati's Pop artist, AVS, gives Music Hall a color saturated makeover in this homage to Cincinnati history. AVS manipulates vintage photography to create an alternate universe of psychedelic, day-glo colors.



### LOT #19 Shepard Fairey

Opening Bid: \$200

Shepard Fairey is one of the most recognized and influential artists in the world. He was recently awarded the Sach's Fund Prize by ArtsWave and his murals are visible throughout Cincinnati. This image of Patti Smith is derived from the massive installation at the CAC.



### LOT #20 Katie Parker + Guy Michael Davis

Opening Bid: \$300

Always pushing the boundaries of design and ceramics, Katie Parker + Guy Michael Davis create objects and installations that both challenge and delight. Taking forms from nature and adorning them with elaborate ornamentation, they imagine a world that suggests a slightly warped version of a peaceable kingdom.



### LOT #21 Stuart Fink

Opening Bid: \$300

Stuart Fink is among the most respected artists in Cincinnati with an extensive exhibition history and having completed numerous public sculpture commissions throughout Cincinnati. His work evokes figures and urban landscapes while maintaining a playful sense of humor.

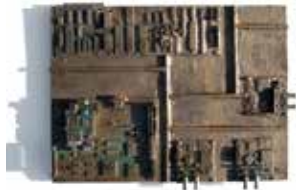
